I graduated as a Physiotherapist from Sheffield in 1988. Since then, I have worked in a hospital setting and in private practice in the UK and in Canada. I completed a post graduate certificate in manual therapy from Sheffield Hallam University in 1996 and gained an OMT qualification in 2005 to become a member of the Musculoskeletal Association of Chartered Physiotherapists (MACP). I have been involved with the International Maitland Teachers' Association (IMTA) since 2001 and in 2013 I became the only UK based qualified IMTA teacher of the Maitland Concept. Since then, I have taught post graduate courses in manual therapy in the UK, Finland, France, Italy, Jordan, Mexico, Norway, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Spain, Switzerland and Poland.

I have worked at Doncaster and Bassetlaw NHS Trust as a lead clinician in primary and secondary care settings and in an extended role as a specialist Orthopaedic Physiotherapy Practitioner. I am qualified in the administration of steroid injections. I currently work independently as a private practitioner and lecture internationally on various post-graduate courses.

I have co-authored the shoulder chapter for the current edition of Maitland's Peripheral Manipulation and was the Consulting Editor for both the current editions of Maitland's Vertebral and Peripheral Manipulation. I am currently working on material for the new editions to be published in 2022.

I am an advocate of manual therapy applied appropriately on the basis of sound clinical reasoning and individual patient need and am committed to providing evidence based, quality care to all patients.
